FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

March 27, 2025 Edition

This is West Valley Cleanup Alliance's (WVCA) second set of Frequently Asked Questions. We appreciate that contract transitions raise questions, and we hope this information helps clarify our work during transition as we prepare to assume the new contract toward the end of June. Some questions have been edited for space/clarity.

Question 6: I am currently employed at the WVDP with UGT. I'm not a CHBWV employee. The information you provided did not seem to cover those employed as a subcontractor. Will there be similar packets for those employees?

The job offer process currently underway by WVCA is intended to hire current CHBWV employees only. We cannot speak for other contractors' future employment plans or processes at the site. We recommend you contact your specific employer to understand future work plans.

Question 7: Will our email addresses change following transition, and if so, what will be the process for that change and when will it take effect?

Yes, email addresses are expected to change. The CHBWV Information Technology team is currently making plans for a coordinated changeover, and it will make an internal announcement to employees about the details as we get closer to the end of transition.

Question 8: I am currently under consideration for a new job with CHBWV. If I accept WVCA's offer of employment, am I still eligible for that new job, and will I receive a new job offer?

You are still eligible for the job you are applying for if you accept WVCA's job offer. If you are offered that new position, accepting it will not change your future employment status with WVCA. We are working closely with CHBWV's Human Resources team to stay coordinated on matters like these so that we don't impede any internal job movements or external hiring that occurs during transition.
